Mr. Morgan: Not at this time.

Mr. Flint: My concern is that we are going to be down to three Supervisors.

Mr. Bundy: Will we have enough time when their term ends, before the next Board meeting?

October 2, 2017 Shingle Creek CDD

Mr. Flint: The Landowner's Election will be at the next meeting, so at that point, we can re-elect whoever the landowner wants to elect.

Mr. Morgan: We are losing Mike.

Mr. Flint: The Landowner's Election will be held before the November Board meeting. You will have Scott, Adam and Mark Gravel, when Mike resigns.

Mr. Morgan: We just have to make sure that Mark shows up.

Mr. Flint: If there are no nominations, we will defer action on the organizational matters, at this point.

Mr. Flint: It looks like Scott is Chairman and Adam is Vice Chairman, so we have signature authority.

FIFTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Consideration of Landscape Enhancement Proposals from Down to Earth

Mr. Smith: The first proposal is for some Sabal Palms. We lost several Sabal Palms. I'm not going to replace all of them. We have quite a few behind the wall. There are two dead ones, which I'm not going to replace. We can replace them at a later date, when we have a larger package of landscaping. I want to transplant one and replace two. The idea is to get the Boulevard looking good. The request for authorization on these proposals are for the Boulevard, primarily medians #2, #3 and #4. Another time we lost some Plumbagos. This is your basic plant material.

October 2, 2017 Shingle Creek CDD

Mr. Morgan: Is that normal loss or is there a maintenance issue?

Mr. Smith: Its new construction loss over a long period of time. You had several different contractors in there doing maintenance. It's not an unusual amount of plant material, at this point. It's just to get it looking back to the way it should be.

Mr. Morgan: So you are going to remove the dead ones and replace a couple of them?

Mr. Smith: I'm going to remove all of the dead ones, transplant one and replace two.

Mr. Morgan: Looks good to me.

Mr. Flint: We need a motion to approve the two proposals.

On MOTION by Mr. Morgan, seconded by Mr. Bundy, with all in favor, the Landscape Enhancement Proposals from Down to Earth, were approved.

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RESOLUTION 2018 - 03

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE SHINGLE CREEK COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT AUTHORIZING A PETITION BE FILED WITH THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF OSCEOLA COUNTY PURSUANT TO SECTION 190.046, FLORIDA STATUTES, TO EXPAND **BOUNDARIES OF** THE SHINGLE CREEK **COMMUNITY** DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT; REQUESTING THAT THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF OSCEOLA COUNTY ADOPT AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE DISTRICT BOUNDARIES OF THE CREEK COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT **DISTRICT:** DIRECTING DISTRICT STAFF TO TAKE APPROPRIATE ACTION TO FILE THE PETITION AND DO ALL THINGS NECESSARY TO EXPAND THE BOUNDARIES OF THE SHINGLE CREEK COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the Shingle Creek Community Development District (the "District") is a local unit of special purpose government duly organized and existing under the provisions of the Uniform Community Development District Act of 1980, Chapter 190, Florida Statutes, as amended (the "Act"), and was created by Ordinance Number 05-15 of the County Commission of Osceola County, Florida (the "County"), effective on May 27, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the District is located wholly within the boundaries of Osceola County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the sole developer and majority landholder within the District is Lennar Homes, LLC, a Florida limited liability company (the "Developer"); and

WHEREAS, the Developer is the fee simple owner of certain real property generally described/depicted in <u>Exhibit "A"</u> attached hereto (the "Expansion Property"), which property is situated adjacent to the existing District boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the Developer has requested, via written communication to the District, that the Expansion Property be included within the boundaries of the District; and

WHEREAS, subject to the conditions contained herein, the District's Board of Supervisors finds it to be in the best interest of the District that its boundaries be expanded pursuant to §190.046, Florida Statutes (the "Statute") in order to include the Expansion Property; and

WHEREAS, the District desires to authorize and direct the District Manager and District Counsel, *inter alia*, to prepare the necessary Petition to the County in order to comply with the

applicable provisions of Chapter 190, Florida Statutes, for the effective expansion of the boundaries of the District as contemplated herein; and

WHEREAS, the District's Board of Supervisors desires that the County adopt a nonemergency ordinance to provide for the expansion of the boundaries of the District in accordance with the Statute and as contemplated herein.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE SHINGLE CREEK COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT:

SECTION 1. INCORPORATION OF RECITALS. All of the representations, findings, and determinations contained within the above Recitals of this Resolution are recognized as true and accurate, and are expressly incorporated into this Resolution.

SECTION 2. AUTHORIZATION FOR PETITION. Subject to the District's receipt of a written acknowledgement or letter agreement from Developer committing Developer to pay for any and all reasonable fees and costs incurred by the District in association with the boundary expansion contemplated herein (regardless of whether it is successful), the District hereby authorizes a Petition be filed with the County pursuant to Section 190.046, Florida Statutes, to expand the boundaries of the Shingle Creek Community Development District to include the Expansion Property as depicted/described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

SECTION 3. REQUEST FOR ACTION. The District hereby requests, and such request shall be repeated in the Petition, that the County adopt a non-emergency ordinance in accordance with Chapter 190, Florida Statutes, providing for the expansion of the boundaries of the Shingle Creek Community Development District in the manner and to the extent reflected in Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

SECTION 4. DIRECTION TO DISTRICT STAFF. The District Manager, District Counsel, District Engineer, and any other District staff deemed necessary, are hereby authorized and directed by the Board to: (i) prepare and file the Petition in a timely manner, (ii) work with all necessary parties to transmit this Resolution to the County along with the Petition to expand the boundaries of the Shingle Creek Community Development District as contemplated herein, and (iii) take all appropriate actions and make all necessary filings to effectuate the expansion of the boundaries of the District consistent with the terms of this Resolution and applicable law.

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. Should any court of competent jurisdiction find or hold any one or more provisions of this Resolution to be invalid or unenforceable, then such provision or provisions, as the case may be, shall not affect the validity or enforceability of the remaining portions of this Resolution, or any part thereof.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon the passage and adoption of this Resolution by the Board of Supervisors of the Shingle Creek Community Development District.

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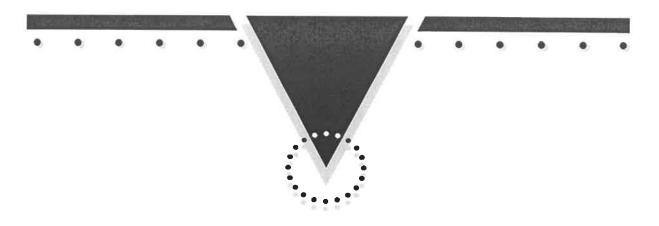
